Sorry to here the same "stuff " is going on at 14946. The second shift Sergeant (Sgt Santaniello) is aware of the ongoing issues there and hopefully will direct his resources to address what's going on during those hours. I have given the OK for two of my first shift officers (Johnson and Richardson) to come in early (2 or 3 am) to see what if anything is happening at the location as well.

Update on the stabbing case: one suspect has been arrested for the Assault with Deadly Weapon Inflicting Serious Injury with Intent to Kill and is currently still in jail. Officer Wrenn has identified another suspect and is still working the case in hopes of securing warrants against him. The third suspect Wrenn is still working to identify.

I'm going to coordinate with Sgt Booth today and hopefully secure the assistance of two of his officers working a special assignment and see if they are available as well. Hopefully if they are, this will result in a POSSIBLE probable cause for a search warrant at the location if all goes well.
